All students in Year 7 have 3 periods per week on their timetable for Arts. Most students study Art, Media and Drama over the year during those 3 periods per week. Music students study Music for 2 of the 3 periods allocated to the Arts; the 3rd period is Art.

Students joining the Specialist Jazz Music Program are required to participate in instrumental lessons on a rotating timetable DURING school time as well as ensemble rehearsals and performances OUTSIDE of school time. Please ensure your child is prepared to fulfill the commitment before applying for the program.

The Specialist Jazz Music Program is a three year program; students need to understand that timetable changes are not made following acceptance into and commitment to the program. Late applications are subject to availability.

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

This program is most suitable for high achieving students who would benefit from enrichment opportunities across the MESH subject areas. Selection for this program will be based on the results of testing which will be held at Mount Lawley Senior High School late in Term 3. More information regarding the testing process will be forwarded to suitable applicants closer to the time. Please be aware there is an \$88 fee which covers the cost of administering the test and having the results analysed by a third party.
